

Bradley Stoke Community School Primary Phase

Bradley Stoke Community School Primary Phase opened in September 2015 with our first cohort of 30 EYFS pupils. Our intake will continue to be 30 Reception children each year; reaching our capacity of 210 pupils in September 2021. As we are the Primary Phase of Bradley Stoke Community School, our pupils will automatically transfer to the Secondary Phase when they reach the end of Year 6. Being part of an all through 4-18 school brings a range of benefits; our children are able to access the specialised resources within the Secondary Phase building and expertise of the specialist secondary staff.

As our children are currently EYFS only, moving into Year 1 in September 2016, we are able to have a high focus on developing outstanding Early Years practice. We work very closely with the South Gloucester Early Years Team, who have a training base in our school. Our staff are all trained to deliver Forest School sessions and we make weekly visits to the woodland and nature reserve that borders our school grounds. We view every aspect of our school day as part of our curriculum provision; this includes a focus on developing social skills through our lunchtime dining routines and a continuation of quality outdoor provision, supported by Teaching Assistants, through lunchtime break. Our academic curriculum is based around themed work supported by quality key texts.

Charborough Road School

Charborough Road School is a Community Primary School, in Filton, North Bristol. We are a medium sized primary school, with 270 pupils on roll. We became an academy, as part of the Olympus Trust in January 2015.

We have nine mainstream classes in the school; there are mixed aged classes at Key Stage One, and larger, single aged classes in KS2. We also have a two-class Resource Base for pupils with Speech, Language and Communication Difficulties. This is a local authority resource, and pupils attend the Base from across South Gloucestershire and Bristol.

Whilst academic standards are high at the school, sport, Forest Schools and the arts are also central to our topic-based curriculum offer, which is based on the principles of 'independence', 'creativity' and 'possibilities'. Each child takes part in a musical production each year, and we have a range of high performing sports teams and clubs. Pupils also take part in fortnightly Forest School sessions, which we call 'Welly Days.' Our aim is to enable children to develop essential skills, to be excited about learning and to be challenged to achieve their very best.

All schools have their own distinctive 'feel' which makes each one unique. We believe that the 'special feel' at Charborough Road is to do with our caring, friendly atmosphere. Our school is a welcoming, happy school where people are helpful, considerate and respectful of each other. Charborough Road children are happy and enjoy learning. We have a dedicated team of teachers, teaching assistants and support staff who strive to ensure that every child is successful, confident and responsible, equipped with all the skills they need to continue on their future learning journey.
