Prior to Interview/What to bring with you...

(In addition to the requirements stated in your invitation)

- ✓ Read the Interview Checklist for your chosen subject, this will help you prepare for the areas that will be covered at interview, and highlight any questions you may wish to ask.
- ✓ Please come dressed in appropriate clothing for animal handling (no nail varnish or jewellery allowed in animal handling sessions)
- ✓ You need to prepare a **handwritten** document (at least one A4 side) answering the following questions...
 - What are you doing at the moment (at school, work etc.)?
 - What do you enjoy about it?
 - Why would you like to study your chosen subject area?
 - What would you like to do after you complete your study programme at SGS?
 - What sort of personal interests do you have?
 - Where do you see yourself in 5 years' time working in the industry?
 - What skills and qualities are required to work in the Animal Science and Conservation Industry

Interview and Taster Event Structure

Whilst you are in College you will receive...

- A **group presentation** about the College and more specifically the Animal Science and Conservation Department.
- An introduction to our **Money Management Service Team** who will advise you about the support they can offer with payments, bursaries, loans and any other financial queries you may have.

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- An introduction to our **Work Placement Team** will also discuss their role in your study programme and the advice and guidance available from their department.
- Finally, you will participate in **short group activities and practical tasks** relating to your chosen subject. This is a fantastic opportunity to get to know your potential peers and meet our staff.

Applicants will be taken for their 1-1 interviews throughout the interview/taster event.

There will be plenty of opportunity to ask any questions throughout the day to help you feel fully prepared for your start in September 2018.
