Please report to Reception on arrival

You must attend an interview to secure a place on your chosen study programme

Prior to Interview/What to bring with you

- Please bring **achieved and/or predicted grades** – A provisional offer will be made based on predicted grades and the result of your interview.
- Please come dressed in **casual clothing** as you will be taking part in a practical session relevant to your chosen subject
- Please bring **safety footwear**, if you have any otherwise we can provide a pair on the day

Interview Structure

- A **group presentation** about the college and more specifically the Plumbing and Electrical Department
- During the interview, we will ask you to complete a **Math and English Assessment**
- Finally, you will participate in a **practical task** relating to your chosen subject. This is a fantastic opportunity to experience your chosen trade and get to know your potential peers and meet our staff

The Interview/Taster Event will last 3hrs and applicants will be taken for their 1:1 interview during this time

You will have the opportunity to ask any questions during your interview to help you feel fully prepared for your start in September 2019.

We run regular interviews and spaces are limited. If you cannot attend your appointment for any reason, please contact our **Admissions Department** on **01453 761165**, who will be able to arrange another date/time for you. Please note if you miss multiple interview dates, this may have a negative impact on your application.
