

### **What can I expect from my interview?**

- **Duration** – You should expect your interview to last up 45 minutes
- Initially you will attend a group presentation followed by a 10 minute

One-to-One interview with a member of the Travel and Tourism teaching team.

- **What happens next?** If you can provide an educational reference to a member of the travel and tourism team during your interview we may be able to offer you a place on your chosen course at the end of the interview. If we need to wait for a reference a decision will be made once a satisfactory reference has been received. Following the decision to offer you a place an offer letter will be issued and posted / emailed to you. You will be invited in for a taster session in June / July where you will have the opportunity to meet all of the travel team and the students you will be studying with. During your taster day you will take part in some travel and tourism related activities and will be provided information about your start date in September 2018

- **Entry Requirements –**

- Level 3 Travel and Tourism**

- Minimum of 4 Grade 4 s or above / equivalent including Maths and English –

- Level 2 Travel and Tourism**

- Minimum of 4 Grade 3s or above / equivalent including Maths and English –

- Air Industry Services: Ground and Air Operations**

- Minimum of 4 Grade 4 s or above / equivalent including Maths and English.

Should reach their 18th Birthday before the end of the course (March)

- Level 1 Hospitality and Tourism**

- Interest in this subject area and a suitable reference
