Interview Structure

- During the interview, we will ask you to complete a **handwritten document** answering the following questions:
 - What are you doing at the moment (at school, work etc)? What do you enjoy about it?
 - Why would you like to study your chosen subject area?
 - What would you like to do after you complete your study programme at SGS?
 - What career path do you intend to follow?
 - What sort of personal interests do you have?

Your 1:1 interview will last around 15 minutes

You will have the opportunity to ask any questions during your interview to help you feel fully prepared for your start in September 2019.

We run regular interviews and spaces are limited. If you cannot attend your appointment for any reason, please contact our **Admissions Department** on **01453 761165**, who will be able to arrange another date/time for you. Please note if you miss multiple interview dates, this may have a negative impact on your application.
