

INVITATION TO INTERVIEW

Dear Applicant,

We are looking forward to meeting you at your interview for the Level 3 Sports Journalism course. Please bring the following material with you to your interview:

1. Media/Creative Work

This could include, but is not limited to;

- Video work you have made (this could be on YouTube or Vimeo, or you can bring in a drive with your work loaded onto it);
- Photographs you have taken;
- Graphic designs; This work could come from coursework, or something you've created in your own time.

If necessary, you can present your work to us on your own phone or tablet, or you can access it via one of our computers.

2. Written Work

We would also like you to bring a recent example of your writing – this could be in the form of reports you've written about sports events, players or teams; stories; essays; film or literature analysis; scriptwriting etc.

3. Recent School Report

Applicants who are still at school or have only very recently left should also bring their most recent progress report which shows predicted grades, and details about attendance and effort.

We don't expect you to be a fully-fledged sports journalist at this stage, so don't worry too much about whether or not your work looks like professional sports media content. We are just looking to understand your career goals and a little of your perspective on the world of sporting activity. If your interview is successful we will invite you to the second stage of the interview process which will require you to attend a Media taster day in late spring/early summer.
