

What can I expect from my interview?

Following registering at reception, a campus tour of our facilities will take place here at WISE this will last approximately 15 minutes.

A group presentation outlining our courses, study programme (inclusive of vocational course; English and Maths; work experience; enrichment/academy and independent study), progression opportunities and wider essential information that will last approximately 15 minutes.

A one-to-one interview with a member of the Public Services and Sport team who will help with bespoke advice and guidance, aiding you to make informed decisions regarding your educational next steps and potential future career pathways (relevant to your predicted/current grades).

What happens next?

If you are successful you will be sent an offer letter, followed by joining instructions later in the year. Please keep an eye out for our department newsletter, which will update you quarterly with subject area information and anything relevant you may need to do in late August.

Your course and level is dependent on the grades you receive from your GCSEs/equivalencies. We have a large breadth of courses that can cater from levels 2 to 5 (HND Protective Public Services) and potentially alternative areas throughout the college.

What do I need to bring/prepare?

Please bring a **pen and pad** should you wish to take any notes your **predicted grades** from school, so we can give you an accurate conditional offer should your interview be successful. We are interested to hear about you, so we would welcome **reports, sample work, references, certificates** and newspaper cuttings although not essential. Please note we will only view and not retain any of your documentation at this point.

Your main interview will last around 15 minutes. But you may be in College for approximately 75 minutes depending on when your slot takes place after the presentation.

Please note that due to the vibrant nature of the site (WISE Campus) the car park can often be busy, please allow adequate time. In addition, if you have arrived at the site with your own vehicle please register the licence plate with reception.
