We are looking forward to meeting you at your interview for the Level 3 UAL Diploma in Creative Media Production and Technology.

In order for us to judge your suitability for the course we would like you to bring to the interview a portfolio of your creative work. This could comprise of video work you have made (on YouTube); photographs you have taken; graphic designs; art work such as painting, drawing, images of 3D work, or a combination of several creative forms.

We would also like you to bring an example of your recent writing – this could be in the form of stories, essays, film or literature analysis, scriptwriting etc.

If you have neither of the above:

We would like you to create a series of 10 images which tell a short story. Keep it simple for examples it could be your journey to school/work and it can be done on your phone if you don't have a camera. Try to think about how you frame the shots in the sequence to tell the story.

For the written work we would like you to write a short piece on what you think the impact is of social media on the lives of your generation. What are the benefits of it? What are the areas that cause concern? Where do you think the next developments will be in the use of social media?
